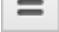
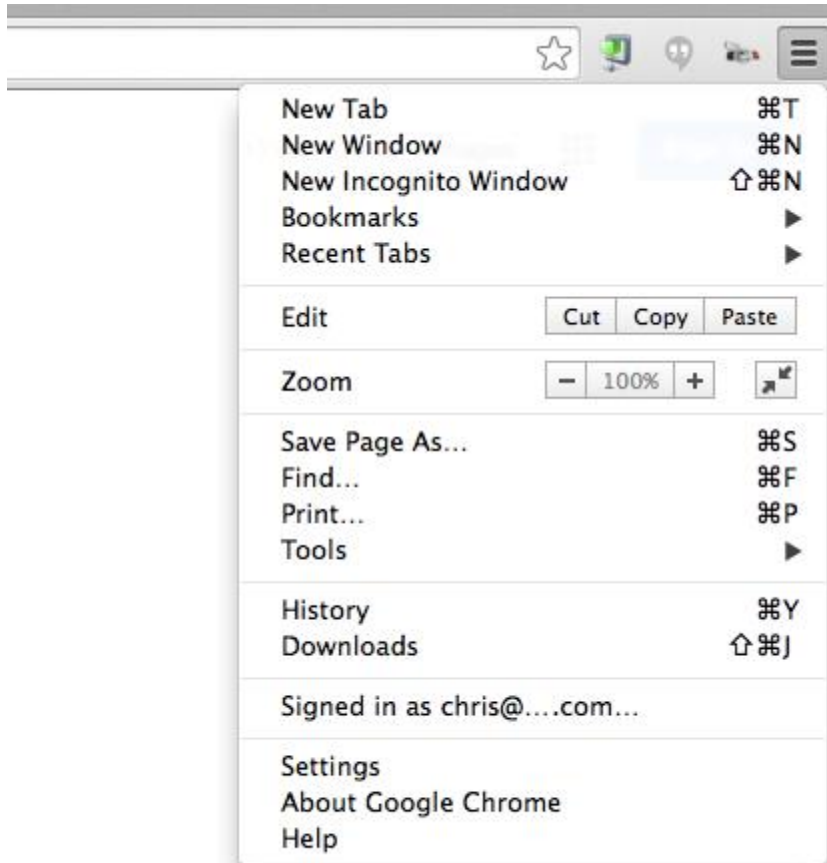


Access the Chrome Menu

1. To begin, select the  menu in the upper corner of Chrome.



2. From this menu you can access the following (keyboard shortcuts are noted to the right):
 - **New Tab**
 - The New tab option will open a New tab on the toolbar
 - **New Window**
 - The New window option will create a completely new window for a user
 - **New Incognito Window**
 - The Incognito window will open and allow the user to search without having their browser results saved
 - Great for when students are sharing devices; where one student is logged in and another needs to access to their Google Account for information
 - **Bookmarks**
 - Bookmarks allow users to manage websites and web resources to revisit within the Google Chrome browser
 - **Recent Tabs**
 - Recent tabs is the Google Chrome menu option that allows users to review and return to any recently visited tabs in Google Chrome

- **Edits**
 - The Edit Feature allows the user to select Cut, Copy and Paste
- **Zoom**
 - Zoom allows the user to zoom in/out of the page for a preferred viewing option
- **Print**
 - Allows to the user to print to local print station or via Google Cloud Print
- **History (Browser)**
 - Use the History page to view a list of websites you have ever visited in the last 90 days while using Google Chrome in standard mode
- **Downloads**
 - Helps the user keep track of all applications and files downloaded on Chrome; also accessible by typing: chrome://downloads in the Omnibox
- **Help**
 - Directs the user to the [Google Chrome Support Center](#)

Note: When using Chromebooks, you will also have an option to login as a guest. Guest mode is a login option that allows you to browse the Internet without using your Google Apps credentials. Incognito mode allows you to open up a tab without having your history saved.
